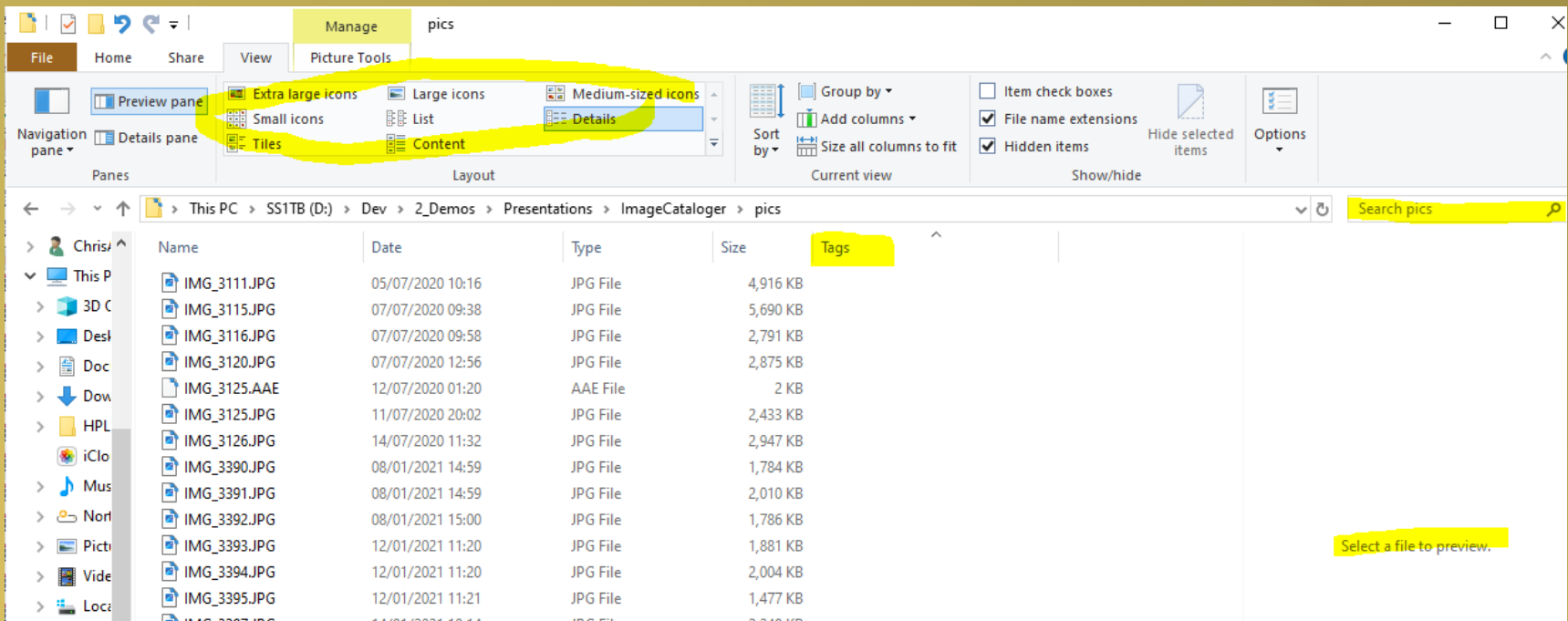

How does Photo Cataloguer work?

Removal Option	Move to a 'deleted' folder ✓	▼
Tag Option	Populate the file meta data ✓	▼
Size Option	50% ✓	▼
Save Option	Move to a category folder ✓	▼

Resize images to save space

ExifTool Info

- ▣ Uses freeware utility ExifTool to assign keywords to metadata
- ▣ ExifTool is a command line tool so needs to be located in a path with no spaces
- ▣ ExifTool for Windows supports a maximum path length of 246 characters for files. Longer path lengths give an "Error opening file" message.
- ▣ In Windows, ExifTool will not process files with Unicode characters in the file name
- ▣ The loading time of ExifTool for Windows increases significantly when Windows Defender is active. Disabling Windows Defender may speed things up

What's Next

- ▣ Enable view of tags on mouse over
- ▣ Enable drag/drop to a specific category
- ▣ Enable ability to multi select images to drop
- ▣ Test out using Edge browser control
